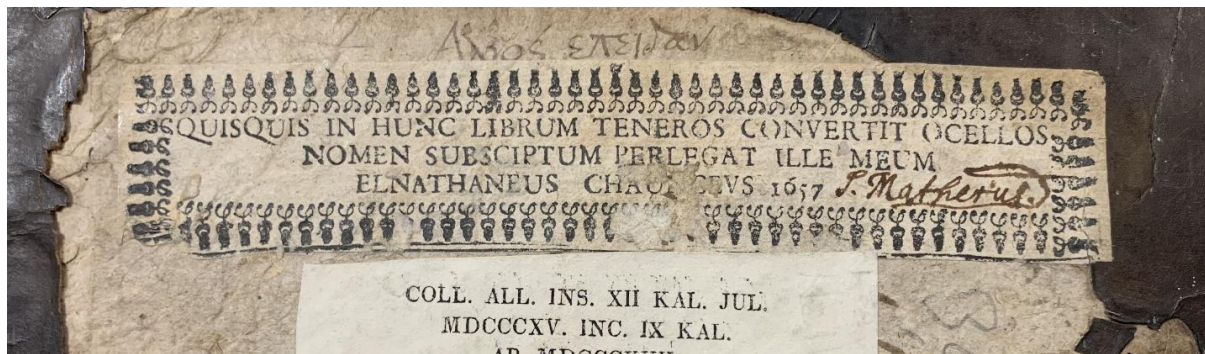

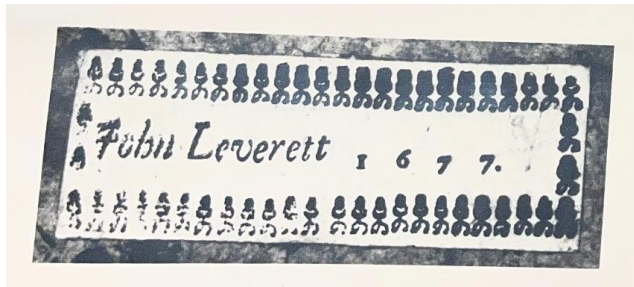

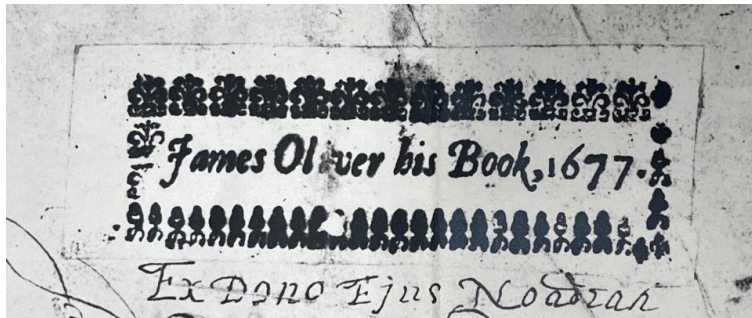

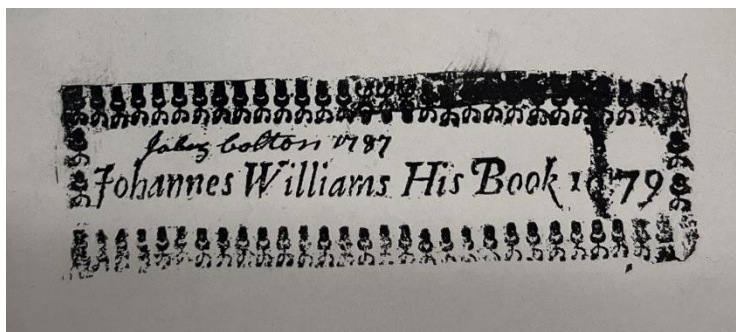
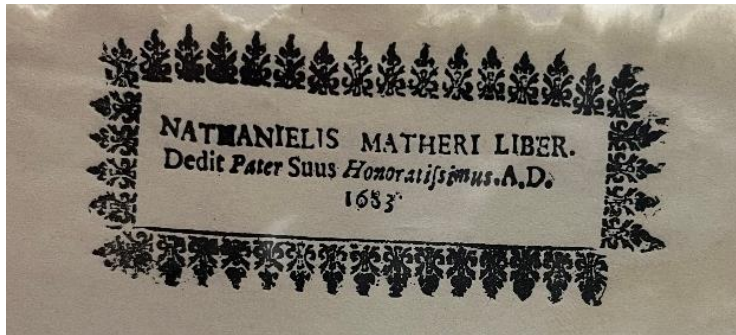

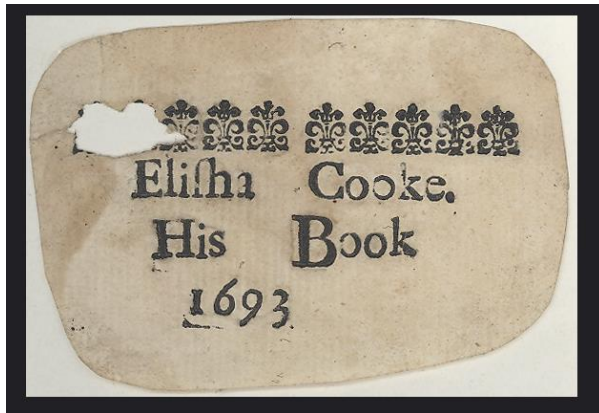

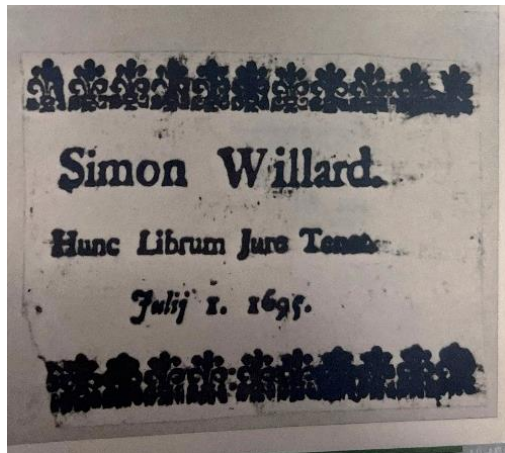

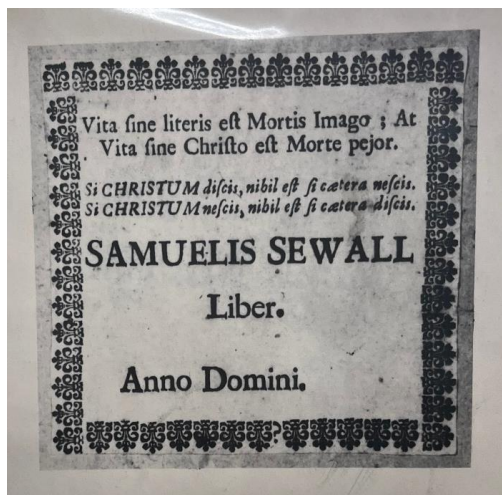

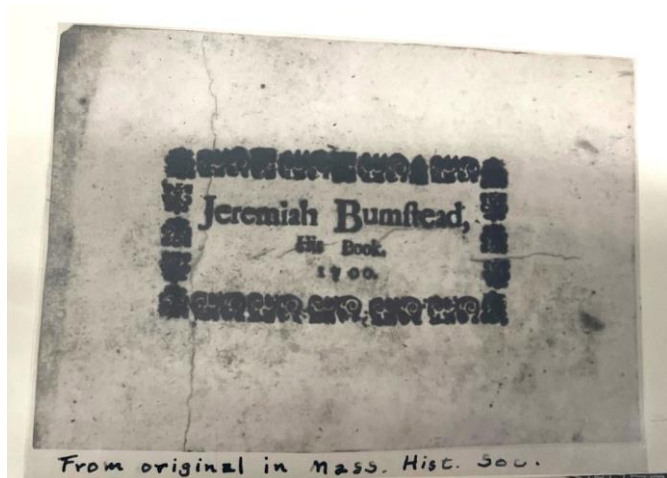
1698? Samuel Sewall (1652-1730) Date estimated as before 1700 by Robert W.G. Vail.
